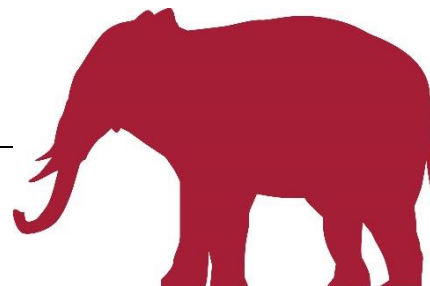


University of Alabama Summer Reading Clinic

INDIVIDUALIZED READING INSTRUCTION
provided by UA Students at the Internship Level

These reading intervention classes are designed for elementary school children (entering grades 1 – 5) who are ending the school year at least one grade level behind and would benefit from a short series of reading intervention lessons as a warm-up for the new school year. UA students in a special education and general education licensure program are the instructors. They have taken the full series of reading courses and will be entering their internships in the fall. They will design lessons specific to the child's needs using SPIRE, a dyslexia-specific intervention curriculum.

45-minute lessons 2-days per week for 3 weeks (6 total lessons)

Classes are held Mondays and Wednesdays (Child attends both days)

1:00 – 1:45 or 2:00 – 2:45 or 3:00-3:45
